NEMO A534 injuries, shot in the left side of his face and the bullet exited near his right eye.

NEMO A534 was the first sentry dog to be sent home to the states from Vietnam. He became a goodwill ambassador for the remainder of his life.

NEMO A534 died Mar 15, 1973.

The hospital was straight out Tan Son Nhut's main gate, approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ mile down on the right.
