## TIME, SEPTEMBER 6, 1971

Isoloted Positions. While the political squabbles stirred up Saigon, Communist artillerymen, defying counterattacks by waves of B-52s, placed isolated South Vietnamese positions just below the Demilitarized Zone under tremendous pressure. Throughout the country, enemy sappers and mortar teams launched scattered attacks on a slew of targets, including the huge U.S. base at Cam Ranh Bay, where an ammunition dump

was set ablaze and spewed forth explosives for twelve dangerous hours. Still, the U.S. command reported only ten American combat deaths—the lowest weekly total since August 1965
