SECURITY
SENTRY DOG/HANDLER POST

LOCATION: 1st MP Battalion, Delta Company Area, Southwest Perimeter.

HOURS: During the hours of darkness, emergency periods, or as directed.

LIMITS: You will remain between perimeter fences, from light pole #102 to Marine Bunker #7.

EQUIPMENT: SSI K- , flashlight, whistle, portable radio w/ear plug, M-16 Sub-machine gun w/270 rds of ammo, sentry dog w/equipment, helmet w/liner, two (2) fragmentation grenades and pop flares.


UNIFORM: As prescribed in SPOI #21.

1. Responsibility:

- a. You are responsible to the K-9 Squad Leader and Security Flight Commander.
- b. You will comply with the contents herein and SPOI's #23, #30, and #41.

2. Your Specific Security Instructions Are:

- a. This is a challenging post and the MACV Rules of Engagement apply.
- b. Immediately upon being posted you will make a thorough check within the limits of your post to insure it is secure and to acquaint yourself with the surrounding terrain.
- c. You will make a radio check upon request from CSC. Thereafter you will keep your radio on, volume low, and make no other transmissions except in case of emergency.
- d. In the event your dog alerts or you suspect any threat to your area you will immediately notify CSC and request assistance.
- e. In case of a mortar attack, general attack, or hostile acts, you will sound the alarm, take cover and keep your area of responsibility under surveillance.
- f. Flares will not be used unless prior clearance has been given by CSC.
