3	1902	THOMAS	CHARDMOURT: Tigt Thomas, "A" Fit Cadr, held guardmount. All personnel present or accounted for, and posted as indicated on the reverse side of this blotter.		
4	2100	THOMAS	CHANDWOULT: TSgt Jones, "B" Flt Codr, held guardmount. All personnel present or accounted for and posted as indicated on the reverse side of this blotter.		
5	2130	THOMAS	TETRUDER: AZC Dounts, Rook #10, reported that he had ob- served an unidentified person on his post and requested assistance. SAT dispatched to assist.		
6	2131	THOMAS	pust fired a single round at an unidentified person who was running on his post. Herter illumination requested. The SAT searched all surrounding posts, but no person was found. Approx 20 morters were fired for illumination and the search was displaced at 2150 hrs. All guards returned to normal duty.		
7	2210	TRONAS	REK AREA: Mortar flares were observed by personnel from this office that were illuminating the REK Area, followed by explosions and tracer fire into and out of the area. SAT dispatched to runsay to inform REK personnel to move to a safer position.		
8	2300		POSSIBLE INTERESTOR: A3C Schwidt, Knight #6, reported hearing voices and observing movement near his post. SAT dispatched and King #6, TSgt Truex, notified. Morter illumination requested, and 7 rounds were fired while area was searched. No intruders found, and search discontinued at 2320 hrs.
