4. Barracks building hit by mortar / rocket - Feb 1968







BATTLE OF BIEN HOA—A time exposure captures the action at Bien Hoa AB when the Viet Cong recently attempted to penetrate the base. Blurred streaks to the right middle are flares dropped from an AC-47. Ellipse of light with diagonal lines running to the center of the action is mini-gun fire from an Army Huey Cohragunship. Focal point of all the fire is Bunker Hill 10 and the area

around it at the east end of the Bien Hoa runway. Enemy forces were stopped by the forces of the Air Force's 2rd Security Police Squadron, Victnamese security police and Army gunships. The enemy lost 153 men killed and 25 suspects detained in their attempt to storm the air base. (USAF PROTO)

The 35th Tactical Fighter Wing at Phan Rang AB. Vietnam, has received the Presidential Unit Citation, highest U.S. military unit award.

The award covered the period Oct. 10, 1966, to April 10, 1967, during which time the wing flew more than 19,000 combat missions.

An accompanying citation pointed out that pilots of the 35th TFW conducted "devastatingly precise attacks that have stopped hostile attacks at the very perimeter of friendly psotions."

The 35th TFW also has earned two U.S. Air Force Outstanding Unit Awards.
