This is a sad morning for us, especially for Janet and her family. She called me earlier this morning to tell me that her father had passed away at 0400 hours this morning after a massive heart attack. She is at the hospital right now with her Mom.

Funeral and memorial information will come later after Janet and her Mom have had some time with family members who are also at the hospital.

Al did so much for the VSPA and for each of us as we had the opportunity to shake his hand and listen to his stories. He was Life Member #127 and a retired Master Sergeant. He served at Cam Ranh Bay AB in 71 - 72. Al's daughter Janet called him "Sarge" and always came to our reunions with him. He loved the VSPA and believed in the goodness of our brotherhood, so much so that he gave memberships to others, including a life membership to Jackie Kays.

Some of you may know Al as the guy who always provided great BBQ in our reunion hospitality room, others may have never met him, but he knew all of you as a brother. He stood quietly in the background, listened and observed, then extended his hand in brotherhood whenever and wherever it was needed. He was the first VSPA member to receive the Warriors Medal of Valor from the Native American Nations and later became the Chairman of our committee to present the Warriors Medal to VSPA members, something that he personally financed for the brotherhood that he loved so much.

We honored Al many times for taking care of his own and being for a great example for all of us. He received a special award from us at the 2007 Reunion named after his very dear friend, Monk, who was also from Alabama and believed with all of his heart in our brotherhood. The "Calvin 'Monk' Pope Award" was presented to Al for consistently taking care of his own.

As we think about a man who loved all of us, it may be easier to think of him without the pain that required so many surgeries,

or to smile at the reception Al received from Monk and our other brothers listed at Life Member #111 when he reported for Guardmount at the gates of Heaven - standin' tall and lookin' good wearing an Air Police Shield and his VSPA brassard, asking if anyone needed a break. Knowing Monk and Al, it would not surprise me that Monk would wrap his arms around Al and say, "Welcome Home, brother! You ain't gonna believe this, but right over here is a cloud full of beer."

We are fortunate to have known Al and blessed that he introduced his daughter, Janet, to all of us. Like Al, Janet has taken care of all of us for many years. Now, it's our turn to take care of them.

Hello to all.

I just spoke with Janet to see how she and her Mom are doing. They are both okay and getting better. They have just completed the arrangements for Sarge's funeral.

As we talked, Janet gave me a few moments of exactly why her Daddy was so proud of her, of why he called her his "Sparkplug" and the fact that she was so very proud of him. She laughed and said, "Hey, I cut my teeth on a Security Police shield. I can do this. He is going home to be a warrior again in his dress blues with full military honors."

We talked about the arrangements, including his love for the VSPA. He will be buried with a VSPA flag, his Life Member pin, his shield and his Warrior's Medal of Valor. Janet did not know how it happened, but felt some devine intervention from the Great Sky Cop in the sky when she was told that Sarge would be buried in plot #111 - just as he would be listed at Life Member #111 with his VSPA brothers who have attended their final Guardmount before him. His cousin, who is a Cherokee tribal chief, will play Amazing Grace on the Native American flute.

Then Janet told me that Sarge had completed the full circle of life, "Today was Daddy's birthday. He was 66 years old today. Now he's going home."
