SIGNIFICANCE

Blue and yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The red torri gate represents the blood shed in war to preserve the peace. The spears denote the two major functions of the unit, security and law enforcement. The coiled snake represents the unit's personnel as vigilant and ready for quick response. The sun and icicles on the gate reflect all weather conditions in which the unit must function. The stars stand for the fourteen campaign credits awarded for the Vietnam conflict.
