
**Security Police Training: Description:**

### **Description:**

Inspired By The Courage Displayed By Air Force Security Policemen At Tan Son Nhut Air Base Near Saigon, Felix Ferrero Memorializes Airmen On The Ground And In The Air Who Fought Off Viet Cong Attackers During Communists Tet Offensive In 1968. Medics And Helicopter Crewmen Evacuate A Wounded Security Policeman As A Bomb And Rocket Laden F-4c Completes Ordnance Drop On Nearby Enemy Forces.

Air Force Patrol The Perimeter Of Biên Hòa AB In Jeeps And Armored Cars. One Spot On The Tour Of Bunkers And Towers Includes This Scene Which Includes A Wrecked French Armored Car--Seen On Trip April-May 1969.

Wrote The Artists: This Was Painted From Sketches. Since This Was In Late August 1967, It Was The Beginning Of The Monsoon Season Which Det-s For The Dramatic Sky Effect. The Repair Gear Gathered At The Field Made Such An Interesting Subject. The Twin-Engine Caribou Is An All-Weather Utility Transport. Its Short Takeoff And Landing (Stol) Characteristics Make It Suitable For Airlift In Forward Battle Areas, Or On Short, Unimproved Airstrips. It Has Been Used Extensively In Southeast Asia.

### **Description:**

Here An Ac-47 Attacks Several Hundred Viet Cong Guerrillas In A Wooded Area Southwest Of Saigon. One Of Its Mini-Guns Fires 6,000 Round A Minute All Three Spread 18,000 Rounds In That Time. The C-47 Was Used Extensively In World War II And Korea. Its Ac Modification Is Useful For The Kind Of Warfare Which Exists In Southeast Asia.
