

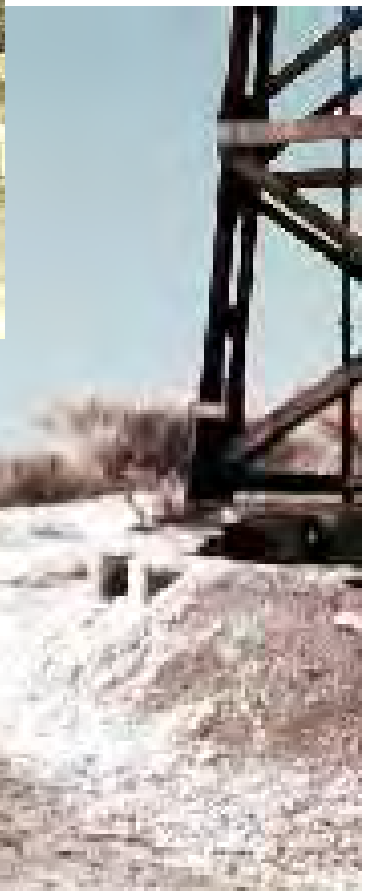


**U-Tapao RTAFB**

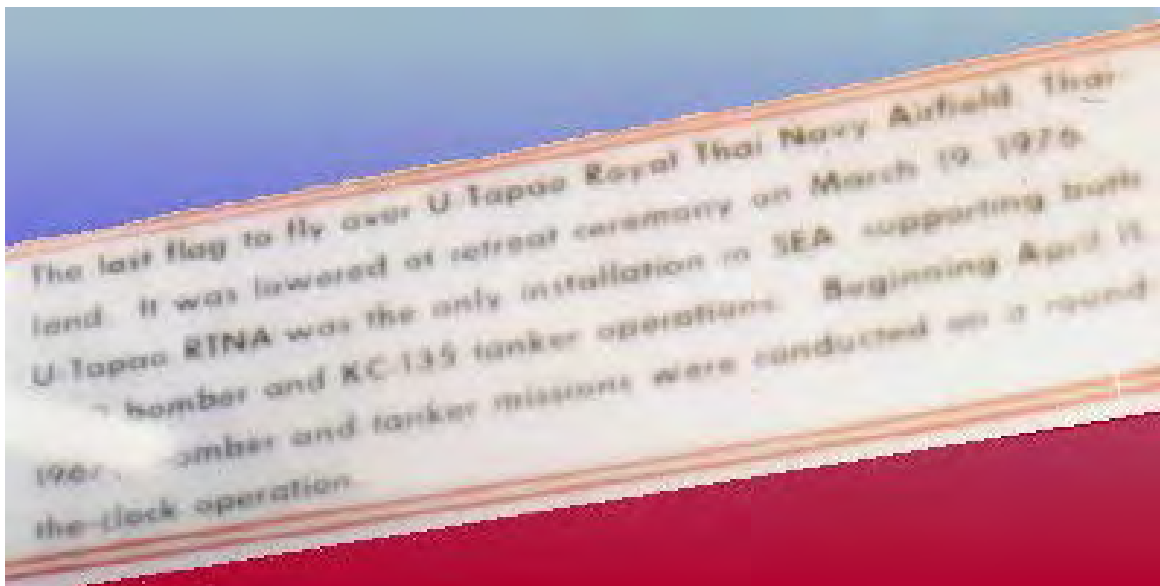
**5. Picture of the baseball field across from the barracks, it also had a few concessions there where you get jackets and caps made to order.**
