

# United States Air Force K9 Sentry Dogs and Handlers Killed In Action 1965-1970 



1965: United States Air Force K9 Sentry Dogs and Handlers were the first U.S. military K9 fighting force in South Vietnam (USAF Operation TopDog45). The first and last K9 War Dogs Killed In Action were both USAF Sentry Dogs. From 1965 to 1972, 230 K9 military dogs from all services were KIA. 394 Handlers were Killed In Action, and five times those numbers were Wounded In Action. It is estimated that the dogs and handlers saved over $\mathbf{1 0 , 0 0 0}$ lives during the Vietnam War, and thus reduced the length of The Wall by 84 feet.

Of the nearly 4,900 dogs that served in Vietnam and Thailand ... only 204 returned home.
