I was assigned to Tainan Air Station, Taiwan in January 1964. In April 1964 I was assigned to temporary duty with the 34<sup>th</sup> Tactical Group at Bien-Hoa AB Vietnam. I was there until October 1964 and returned to finish my tour on Taiwan.

While requesting information from the personnel records center a few years ago I learned there was no record of my Viet-Nam duty. They said that temporary duty orders were purged and destroyed after a period of years.

After much correspondence with the Air Force I was told adamantly that that my Viet-Nam service was not on record and I could not get proof of it and that was the end of it. I contacted my U.S. Rep.'s office and told them of my situation and after much correspondence with the Air Force they were told the same thing. They ask if there were any records in my possession that might shed light on the matter, the only item I had retained was a restricted area pass. I remembered that I had gone to the dispensary at Bien-Hoa and they ask me to request my medical records, which I received and there were two entries of treatment in June and July 1964. I forwarded this to the rep.'s office which they sent to the air force.

Based on this they did then give me credit for those two months service. I am sending along a copy of that letter.

I hope this will suffice to verify my service as I would like to join the association.
