In Genesis 14, four powerful eastern kings ally against an inferior force of five Levantine kings. The smaller city-states are easily defeated, and the people captured, including the nephew of Abram (later named Abraham).

In the Hebrew Bible/old Testament (Israel and Judah period, 930 BCE), until the fall of Judah due to the Babylonian conquest of Jerusalem in 587 BCE. The military and religious conflict between the Kingdom of Israel and Kingdom of Judah is claimed to have originated with the rejection of idolatrous practices introduced by King Solomon.
