After Mayaguez was over we went back out to the crash site (maybe a week or two later, CRS) and bought back a piece of the site. A local farmer near the crash site had part of KNIFE-13's main rotor blade. We needed the pieces for the accident investigation team. The helicopter that crashed was from the 21st SOS (our sister squadron). They were the ones that put the Special Forces guys in behind enemy lines and went back at a	specified time to get them. My squadron, the 40th ARRS, was strictly Search & Rescue. When Mayaguez went off, both squadrons were called to go on the operation and were "lending" crewmembers to fill helicopters. Some of our pilots were flying 21st SOS birds and some of their Flight Engineers were on loan to the 40th ARRS for the Mayaguez mission. Everything happened so fast. It's like we were notified mid mornig the day before and the next day we were in U-Tapao. It was only a short time before the crash-- the crash site was only eight or nine miles from NKP-- they had just got on the helicopter and were flying out of the area heading to U-Tapao when it happened.
