MEMORANDUM FOR GENERAL MEMOREM

SUBJECT: Spray Aircraft for Monthly Cimirel

- 1. Columni Mosely, MACY-IS Ministelle Project Officer), called our office this morning requesting furnishing statemes on inferrodism that we may have regarding spray equipped S-IIII strength statemed in Theiland.
- 2. It seems that General Washingstond has lucked the MACY state with the responsibility for equipping a many type sirplane to be used in South Vicinain for mosquito control.
- 3. Colonel Mosely and I contacted Colonel Prochlick, Commander 315th ACW for information concerning the spray equipped C-123's in Thatland and to solicit his ideas and recommendation for establishing such a mosquito control program in South Vietnam. Colonel Prochlick stated that the 506 Composite ACS located at Nathen Phondin, Thatland has six of these aircraft and sine crows and that they could be readily equipped with wing booms and tanks if the decision was made to select one of these aircraft to fill the requirement. However, Colonel Prochlick and Colonel Mosely both concur that with the arrival of the eighteenth C-123 RANCH HAND equipped aircraft this month, that the shortage of herbicide chemical in country could allow the use of a RANCH HAND airplane for mosquito control on a short-time basis to meet the 1 March date established by General Westmoreland, or unfil such time as the contract for additional herbicide delivery to south Vietnam could be effected.
- 4. Based on the above information MACV will propose to 7th AF that a 18th ACS RANCH HAND airplane be configured for momento control descining 1 Mar 67. It is further proposed that the selected aircraft be painted a distinctive color (possibly a loud yellow) and that

leaflets be dropped simultaneously with each maquite spray operation telling the Vietnamese people that this airplane is a good hird and that it will kill the harmful mosquite. It was also proposed that every effort be made to condition the Vietnamese people of this program by landlet or any other means available juster to flying an aircrail into a selected area.

5. Recommendation: That a 7th AF RANCH RAND aircraft allocation for purpose outlined above be favorably considered upon receipt of official requirement.
