







## THE ARTICLES

- I am an American fighting man.
   I serve in the forces which guard my country and our way of life. I am prepared to give my life in their defense.
- 1 will never surrender of my own free will. If in command, I will never surrender my men while they still have the means to resist.
- 3. If I am enptured I will continue to resist by all means available. I will make every effort to escape and aid others to escape. I will accept neither parole nor special favors from the exemy.
- 4. If I become a prisoner of war, I will keep faith with my fellow priseners. I will give no information nor

- take part in any action which might be harmful to my comrades. If I am senior I will take command. If not I will obey the lawful orders of those appointed over me and will back them up in every way.
- 5. When questioned, should I become a prisoner of war, I am bound to give only — name, rank, service number and date of birth. I will evade answering further questions to the utmost of my ability. I will make no oral or written statements disloyal to my country and its allies or harmful to their cause.
- 6. I will never forget that I am an American fighting man, responsible for my actions, and dedicated to the principles which made my country free. I will trust in my God and in the United States of America.
