**Early reports:**

A 22-year-old New Fairfield man was killed in the line of duty while serving with New York's Air National Guard in Afghanistan. Todd James "T.J." Lobraico died this week. His family was notified this morning, town officials said. According to the U.S. Department of Defense, Lobraico died from wounds sustained when enemy forces attacked his unit with small arms fire near Bagram Air Field, Afghanistan.

**WEST NYACK** - A United States airman based in the Hudson Valley has been killed in action while in Afghanistan. Officials say Staff Sergeant Todd James Lobraico, 22, was killed Thursday while serving with the New York Air National Guard.
