To: All 7AF Bases (BSP)

More emphasis is required on vegetation control around the perimeters of Seventh Air Force installations. If no action is pending, immediate steps should be taken to survey your perimeter for vegetation control and work with civil engineering to come up with a vegetation control program. Aerial spraying, earth moving machines and other techniques such as burning should be considered. If a serious vegetation problem exists which affects security of the installation and all local efforts have failed, this Headquarters (IGSS) should be advised along with maps pointing out problem areas and what action you have taken to date.
